Late Seminar Registration Surcharge- **\$33.00***

All seminars REQUIRE pre-registration as class size is restricted

*Late registration is defined as any registration after the close of seminar. Seminar registration closes at midnight three days prior to the seminar. For example, Saturday seminars close at 11:59 PM Tuesday. Brand-new, first-year Level 1 officials are exempt from this surcharge.

Late registrants will be admitted only if space is available. Checks or money orders will only be accepted at the seminar location. Per USA Hockey mandate, cash cannot be accepted.

You may change your seminar selection online. Fee for this change is \$10.00.

• **All seminars REQUIRE pre-registration as class size is restricted. No walk-up registrations will be permitted!**

• **On-Ice sessions require full officiating equipment (including a clear half-shield visor attached to your helmet) for returning officials. New officials require only a helmet, skates and clear half-shield visor attached to the helmet.**

• **ATTENDANCE AT THE ENTIRE SEMINAR IS MANDATORY**

This means that to receive credit you must:

- attend a Seminar **FOR THE SAME LEVEL** that you registered with USA Hockey
- arrive on time
- participate in the on-ice session
- stay until the seminar is officially over
- *No exceptions will be made!*

Disruptive officials will be asked to leave and will not receive credit.

- *Pen/Pencil and paper is required*
 - *Bring your Rule Book*
 - *All Day Seminars have on-ice instruction*
 - *You must have a hockey helmet, ice skates and clear half-shield visor attached to your helmet to participate in the on-ice session*
 - *Previously registered officials must have full officiating equipment for on-ice session*
 - *Participation in the on-ice session is mandatory*

USA Hockey Registration Level Information

LEVEL 1 New applicants or Level 1 officials

LEVEL 2 Must have been Level 1 or higher (Complete) within the last two seasons
A closed book exam will be administered - Be sure to prepare for this exam. Accommodations will be made for officials needing assistance with their closed book examination. Requests must be made to the WHOA Educational Coordinator (education@wihoa.org) at least 7 days in advance for accommodations to be made.

LEVEL 3 Must have been Level 3 or higher (Complete) within the last two seasons -or- Must have been Level 2 (Complete) last season
A closed book exam will be administered - Be sure to prepare for this exam. Accommodations will be made for officials needing assistance with their closed book examination. Requests must be made to the WHOA Educational Coordinator (education@wihoa.org) at least 7 days in advance for accommodations to be made.

LEVEL 4 Only officials registered at Level 3 or Level 4 last year
A closed book exam and skating exam will be administered - Be sure to prepare for this exam. NOTE: Skating exam will not be administered in 2021. Accommodations will be made for officials needing assistance with their closed book examination. Requests must be made to the WHOA Educational Coordinator (education@wihoa.org) at least 7 days in advance for accommodations to be made.

- Register Online (credit card payment required) to receive the seminar of your choice subject to availability. No cash accepted.
- Seminars will be filled on a first come - first served basis. All officials **MUST** pre-register. No drop-ins or walk-ups accepted at and WHOA seminar.

- The early registrant is likely to receive his/her first choice

- Some Seminars have multiple locations for different experience and registration levels

- Your Seminar Confirmation will be emailed to you and will indicate the specific location to which you must report at the start of your Seminar
